


Global VC funding for Digital Health companies in first half of 2018 saw more deals and more money raised than first half of 2017

NON-TRADITIONAL PLAYERS ARE FILLING THE VOID

Non-traditional players, from Silicon Valley tech giants to consumer products companies, have made moves into health care

IN 2018, STATE AND FEDERAL LEGISLATION HELPED TO PAVE THE WAY FOR TELEHEALTH AND DIGITAL HEALTH, BUT CHALLENGES REMAIN.



- $\cdot \mbox{ Reducing Unnecessary Senior Hospitalization (RUSH) Act of 2018 \ refers to possibly using telehealth to \ reduce unnecessary senior hospitalizations \\$
- CMS releases proposed rule as part of the Pathways to Success program to, among other things, allow ACOs the opportunity to expand telehealth services by removing various barriers to the provision of telehealth services
- $\cdot \ Illinois \ Medicaid \ expands \ list \ of \ practitioners \ eligible \ for \ telehealth \ reimbursement$
- · California, Illinois, Maryland, Maine, Michigan, Pennsylvania and Washington advance proposals or rulemakings to expand access to telehealth services, lists of practitioners eligible for telehealth reimbursement, and/or provide insurance and reimbursement for telehealth under state Medicaid plans
- Advantage telehealth benefit added by Bipartisan Budget Act of 2018
